## Core Values

The Worship Ministry has certain values that are displayed through all areas of ministry. They are always in operation and are often happening simultaneously. These values come together to help create a culture in the worship ministry that is both felt and measurable. ### HONOR

- Magnify God's name by drawing others to focus on Jesus.
- Create space for people to encounter God's character and goodness.
- Be aware of God's work in the moment and respond appropriately.
- Encourage people and share God's love with them.
- Connect warmly with people before and after the service; show all people respect.

### CHARACTER

- Invest in your relationship with God consistently.
- Live a life of worship and develop a servant's heart.
- Abide by the worship team lifestyle guidelines and dress code.
- Be humble & teachable. Ask for and apply constructive feedback.
- Be faithful. Do what you say you're going to do.
- Show extreme ownership: *How can I take responsibility to make this situation better? What can I do to help?*

### EXCELLENCE

- Abide by the worship team responsibilities and expectations.
- Practice before rehearsal. Rehearsal is for preparing to lead worship.
- Be punctual. Arrive early to be ready to go at your call time.
- Be prepared. Music sheets, gear, and all needed supplies are ready to go.
- Do your best in everything with what you have; don't get caught in perfectionism.
- Learn song structures and musical parts as written before improvising.

### GROWTH

- Push yourself to get better and grow in your craft consistently.
- Have a pioneering mentality -- always moving forward and growing.
- Be open to new ideas. If you have an idea to share, let your leader know.
- Mentor team members in musicianship and relationship with God. You will grow!

### COMMUNITY

- Invest time to attend community team events.
- Connect with and pray for your team between services and after rehearsal.
- Celebrate others for their growth and wins. Realize it's not about you.
- Bring your best by investing consistently in your relationship with God.
- Realize that we are a team and need one another to function at our best.
- Be available to connect with and pray for people after services.

### MENTORING

- Create full-circle Christians on and off your team. Display extreme ownership.
- Mentor team members in musicianship and relationship with God.
- Mentor those outside your team to help them grow in skill as needed.
- Be willing and available to be mentored by others.
- Pass on the core values of the worship ministry in mentoring relationships.
