1 **Introduction**

2 **Worship Team Member Role**

3 **Worship Team Member Responsibilities**

Worship team members are expected to:

- Cultivate and maintain a healthy and growing relationship with God
- Interact courteously with their fellow team members and campus leaders
- Mentor members of other worship teams with a similar instrument / skill set when needed
- Come to each worship service they lead on time and prepared to the best of their ability
- Come to rehearsals on time and prepared to play their role to the best of their ability
- Practice their instrument outside of rehearsals in order to support the team, fully prepared
- Submit themselves to the leadership of the worship team leader
- Give the worship team leader as much notice as possible when unavailable to serve
- Seek the help of their worship team leader regarding issues of involvement with the team
